

Volunteer Roles and Requirements Training Camps

Raleigh International Bermuda is seeking 2-4 individuals to volunteer at our training camps:

- February 9 – 12 at Ports Island
- April 6 – 10 Island-wide

Responsibilities

- Work directly with the head trainers to deliver training activities and to facilitate camp
- Potentially design/deliver training activities
- Assist with camp set-up, cooking, photography, and as needed

Volunteer Criteria

- Able to commit to entire camp and staff activities, specifically
 - FEBRUARY CAMP
 - 1-2 hour pre-camp Staff Training Session in February
 - 1 day/night of team-building, camp set-up (February 9)
 - 3 days/2 nights of camp (February 10 – 12)
 - 1 Post-Camp meeting
 - APRIL CAMP
 - 5 days/4 nights of camp (April 6 – 10)
 - 1 Post-Camp meeting
- High level of maturity
- Willingness to assist in a variety of ways and as needed
- Understanding of and commitment to uphold and enforce the Raleigh rules
- Sincere desire to assist Raleigh's participants and staff
- Ability to uphold the highest standards of confidentiality (i.e. to ensure that you do not gossip about participants on the program after the event)
- Ability to maintain an appropriate relationship (with boundaries) with participants (i.e. to be professional and not talk about social matters, gossip about shared acquaintances, flirt, etc with participants.)
- To uphold the image of Raleigh's Program as a professional youth development opportunity. Not to contradict Raleigh staff members by relating stories of rule-breaking etc on expedition.
- Ability to share powerfully about your personal experience of the program; how it helped you overcome obstacles in your life and what you now see is possible in your life.
